# Key objectives

1. **Map and Explain** the connections between policies, environmental sustainability, and social well-being.
2. **Assess Indicators and Tools** for analysing climate, environmental, and social interactions.
3. **Understand Green and Just Transition Policies** and their social impacts.
4. **Highlight the Role of Institutional, Regulatory, and Legal Frameworks** in Europe.
5. **Recommend Policy Changes** and enhance dialogue on just transition pathways.



# Workplan

WP1 starts with a broad **mapping of policy-impact linkages**.

The outputs from WP1 will inform the refinement of the **analytical framework** (WP2), which will then be used in WP3 to conduct a set of **15 case studies** covering national and regional backgrounds, and an analysis of the role of **institutional, regulatory and legal mechanisms and structures** (WP4).

The project foresees the establishment of a research and public information network: **GreenPaths Knowledge Hub** (WP5, WP6, WP7 and WP8).
